Cross Border Adjustment Mechanism (CBAM)



As it stands:

Affects Iron, Steel, Hydrogen, Fertiliser, Electricity, Cement, Aluminium


Applies at sheet import stage

The further away, and the greater the carbon content, the more you will eventually pay



CBAM

- Talk to your distributor
- Ask them to assess their CBAM liability and potential for cost change
- Prepare for a big change (potentially)
- "Complex CBAM Goods"


